



## **Expressions of Interest Land Degradation / Soil Erosion Projects**

The Northern Rivers Catchment Management Authority (NRCMA) has funding available to assist landholders to rehabilitate land degraded by gully erosion and mass movement in targeted areas of the northern rivers region.

**We are currently seeking expressions of interest from individual landholders in the Tweed, Richmond, Brunswick, Clarence and Coffs Harbour catchments for small soil conservation projects that demonstrate sound technical merit and cost effective treatment of land degradation.**

Technical assistance will be given to applicants for the preparation of site plans or works plans, and successful projects will need to be planned and implemented in accordance with sound soil conservation principles.

Funding will be provided for items such as plant hire, construction materials, technical design (if necessary), management fencing and revegetation of the approved sites. Funding must be complimented with in-kind contributions from the landholder.
