Advanced Biological Farming is for farmers who have completed the basic Biological Farming Course. Advanced Biological Farming will enable farmers to develop their written biological farm plans. The focus will be on integrated farm management of:

1. GROUNDCOVERS AND MANAGEMENT
2. PLANT NUTRITION AND SOIL HEALTH
3. COMPOST PRODUCTION AND USE
4. PLANT PROTECTION

Note the course outline details are not fully developed. This is the first Advanced Biological Farming course offered so participants will have the opportunity to discuss course programme and direction with Dave at the first meeting.

Farmers will choose one or more biological farming practices being incorporated on their respective farms as course assessment report.

On completion of course and submission of assessment the TAFE course fee of \$219.00 will be reimbursed.
