

What does *drumMUSTER* mean for chemical users?

Why use the *drumMUSTER* program?

drumMUSTER is the **only** responsible method for disposal of chemical containers. By using the program chemical users are;

- limiting site risk

- Chemical users are provided with a **receipt** for all drums delivered to the program.

Which containers are accepted at a *drumMUSTER* collection?

Steel or plastic agricultural chemical drums.

Residue free with All lids removed.

Containers from participating manufacturers should have the *drumMUSTER* eligible container logo attached.

Steel drums should have the base punctured.
